ZZ Top, Buckcherry, Cinderella, Godsmack, Tesla and more will headline the Rocklahoma music Memorial Day weekend concert and camping festival, May 28-30 in Pryor.

More bands will be announced soon, organizers confirmed.

The three-year-old festival will broaden its musical scope to include classic, current and up-and-coming rock acts, varying from the prominent “hair metal” music of the ’80s, organizers confirmed.
